Week One

July 6

OOEY GOOEY: A week of messy, sensory fun! Campers explore slime, foam, mud, and paints through hands-on experiments, DIY labs, and fizzy reactions. Encourages creativity and full sensory play. Be prepared to get gooey!

Week Two

July 13

SPORTS WEEK: High-energy fun focusing on teamwork and movement. Campers play soccer, basketball, relay races, and obstacle courses. We emphasize skill-building and sportsmanship in inclusive activities for all athletic levels.

Week Three

July 20

ART ATTACK + INVENTORS : Unleash creativity with painting, sculpture, and mixed-media art. Inventors then brainstorm and build imaginative creations using recycled materials. This week blends artistic expression with hands-on STEM challenges.

Week Four

July 27

MAGIC WEEK: A week of wonder, illusion, and imagination. Campers learn simple magic tricks, design props, and explore the science of illusions. The week ends with a mini "Magic Show" to perform their new skills.

Week Five

Aug 3

CAMPING & WATER WEEK: Ultimate outdoor adventure! Enjoy camp activities like nature walks, shelter building, and trail games. Plus, lots of water fun, including splash activities and relays, perfect for hot days and teamwork.

Week Six

Aug 10

COOKING AROUND THE WORLD: Young chefs explore global flavors and cultures. Campers learn basic kitchen skills while preparing safe, kid-friendly recipes inspired by different countries. A delicious, educational week of culinary creativity.

Week Seven

Aug 17

STEM +MAD SCIENCE: Science takes centre stage with explosive experiments and building challenges. Dive into robotics, engineering, chemistry, and problem-solving games. Encourages campers to think like scientists and innovators.

ALL CREATURES BIG & SMALL: An animal-themed adventure! Campers explore habitats, create animal crafts, study nature, and play wildlife-inspired games. Features scavenger hunts and outdoor discovery for all animal lovers.
